Spanning dozens of departments and programs, the organization relies on secure and efficient inventory and IT asset tracking to improve outcomes and reduce operational waste.

The Challenge: Centralizing IT Asset Tracking Across Dozens of Programs

Before implementing our Passport Asset Tracking Solution, CHCS used Excel spreadsheets to manage IT assets, which introduced several key challenges:

- Lack of Visibility: Equipment was dispersed across more than 50 programs with no way to track movement.
- **Bundled Equipment Issues:** Devices like laptops often came with multiple accessories (docking stations, jetpacks, etc.) that were difficult to track together.
- Audit and Compliance Gaps: The finance team had no reliable way to retrieve reports or track asset history.
- Security and Accuracy Risks: Errors from manual entry and shared spreadsheets caused missing or duplicated data.


