About Hickam Air Force Base

Hickam Air Force Base is a major U.S. military installation on the island of Oahu, Hawaii, and home to the United Pacific Air Force. With over 2,850 acres and a valuation exceeding \$444 million, the base supports critical defense operations and must maintain full readiness at all times.

Captain John Fowler, IT Consultant and Coordinator for the Critical Care Air Transport Team (CCATT), needed a way to manage and track equipment while also fulfilling his duties in the ICU and on missions.

The Challenge: Managing High-Value Medical Supplies in Real Time

Before implementing our combined Inventory System and asset tracking software Passport solution, Hickam faced multiple issues:

- Manual Tracking Burden: Fowler was manually tracking equipment, restocking, and maintenance, creating inefficiencies.
- Lack of Centralization: Inventory data was not centrally stored, making updates and audits difficult.
- **Compliance Demands:** Needed to meet federal requirements, including expiration dates, batch-lot tracking, and serialized inventory.
- Mission-Critical Readiness: Supplies and equipment needed to be ready and operational at all times.


